Rules

- The tournament is sanctioned and ranked by the ITBA and will be governed by the general playing rules plus the following special rules.
 (A) Players must wear a suitable bowling shirt. Names on shirts are required for Ranking Points.
- (B) A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of dispute, which cannot be settled on the spot.
- (C) All protests must be submitted to the tournament committee in writing within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring.
- (D) The tournament will be a re-entry singles; bowling five games over five pairs of lanes.
- (E) All averages must be sent in advance with your entry. Handicap will be based on 80% of 200. Only those with 200 average, or under, qualify for entry into the Handicap Section. Highest current league or tournament average over a minimum of 21 games will be used. Proof of average is required. The Tournament Director has the right to reject or re-rate an average in the interest of the Tournament.
- The tournament director will allow no unreasonable delays in the progress of a game. Should a bowler refuse to proceed with a game after being directed to do so by the tournament director, such game will be declared forfeit.

- Any individual whose conduct is deemed to be prejudicial to the best interest of the sport on or off the lanes during the entire period of the Tournament may be disqualified from the Tournament and will be reported to their national association.
- All bowlers must sign their official score sheet on completion of each round.
- Bowling balls must conform to FIQ specifications of weight, balance and hardness. It is prohibited to use chemical solvents to alter the hardness of a ball after manufacture.
- All bowlers must register at least 15 minutes before their scheduled bowling time.
- 7. The tournament manager will be Mark Delany.
- 8. The tournament director will be Paddy Kilduff.
- The tournament manager reserves the right to reject any entry in the closed sections and reschedule any entry in the interest of the tournament.
- 10. Prize fund is based on 250 entries. The prizes will be adjusted depending on actual entries. In the event of a tie for any position the respective prizes wil be shared. Bowlers may only win a prize in one category
